- Planes: World Models SkyRaider Mach II or LA Racer.
- Engine: Recommended – TT .40 Pro - Acceptable: Any .40 cid "sport" engine, available locally at retail for under \$120.00. No Jetts, no Nelsons, No special Racing Engines!!!! Stock engine, stock carb, stock muffler. Must idle and must shut off on command.
- Fuel: SUPPLIED (15%)
- Fees: \$15.00 per pilot. Includes lunch ticket.
- Rewards: Mostly Bragging Rights. Will recognize Fastest Lap Time, and 1st through 3rd.
- Course: Two-pylon, 400 ft.
- Heats: 4 Heats, Standing Start, Ten Lap Heats.

Hard hats will be required for pilots!!

Race Director's decisions on engine and aircraft eligibility will be final!

We will run 4 heat races, followed by elimination rounds based on points from heat races.

This event will be in compliance with the AMA Safety Code.
